Da Vinci Residency/Fellowship Training Equivalency Certificate Requirements and Letter

Multiport and/or Single-Site Training

Background

A growing number of surgical residency and fellowship programs now include the use of the da Vinci system as part of their curriculum. A resident or fellow who completes such a program and goes on to seek employment at a hiring hospital may find that the hiring hospital is interested in learning more about the resident's/fellow's da Vinci system experience. To help residents/fellows communicate this information, Intuitive has established a Certificate of da Vinci System Training for qualifying residents and fellows.

The Certificate of da Vinci System Training is not a replacement for any hospital's credentialing requirements and is not a representation of clinical competence, as Intuitive only trains on the use of the da Vinci system.

In order to qualify for a Certificate of da Vinci System Training, a resident or fellow must satisfy all of the criteria listed below. Completion of each activity should be documented in a da Vinci Skills Tracker for Residents & Fellows worksheet (PN1024649). Upon completion of the activities below, the online assessment certificate, case log (recommended), and letter from program director or chief of surgery should be submitted to Intuitive for equivalency certificate consideration.

In order to qualify for a da Vinci System Training Equivalency Certificate, residents and fellows must complete all of the requirements listed:

Online introduction to the da Vinci system which covers topics such as:

- Da Vinci system overview and/or
- Da Vinci Single-Site technology overview
- OR setup, system connections and startup
- Vision system

- Patient Cart and draping
- Docking and intraoperative Patient Cart use
- Safety features

2. Da Vinci System In-service Training

Hands-on introduction to the da Vinci system which covers topics such as:

- OR setup, system connections and startup
- Surgeon Console
- Vision Cart
- Instruments and accessories
- Port placement

- Docking
- Instrument insertion and port hopping
- Intraoperative use
- Emergency procedures
- Cleaning and sterilization

- Powering off and storing the system
- Troubleshooting
- Communication

4. Documentation

- Online assessment certificate(s)
- Letter from the chief of surgery or equivalent verifying da Vinci technology training and the procedures in which the surgeon participated
- Case Log (optional). Performance of procedures using the da Vinci system in primary role of console surgeon (20 recommended) and primary role of bedside assistant (10 recommended)

Once completion of the above requirements has been confirmed, a da Vinci System Training Equivalency Certificate may be supplied.
